- Personal sessions are provided to approximately 400 individuals each month.
- Regardless of income, sometimes we need someone to talk to.
- Our counseling clients range in age from five to eighty-five.
- Five Counselors are available in New Castle and Ellwood City.
- Our Psychologist completes custody and disability evaluations.
- We have two Psychiatrists with one specializing in children and adolescents.
- We accept most insurance payments or self payment based on income.

- The Women In Need Program in conjunction with Real Alternatives of Pennsylvania can help by providing free pregnancy tests, personal support, counseling and free diapers.
- Counselors are available in New Castle, Sharon, New Wilmington, East Brady, Farrell and Ellwood City.
- Items such as shampoo, wipes, powder and baby bottles are provided when we have them available.



Imagine...there is no food to give your children tonight.

- Our Food Pantry served 177 families made up of 508 individuals in December of 2011.
- For the entire year of 2011 we served 5,046 hungry people.
- Our pantry *never* has enough food to adequately fill every box needed.
- The pantry is supplied by FEMA, the Pittsburgh Food Bank, and donations from organizations, businesses, schools and individuals.
